- All parents/guardians when collecting/dropping their child for/after fixture free or half term break or at term start/end are required to report and sign in/out their child at the Headmaster's office/hostel before leaving or collecting their child and get a clearance pass.

- Only the enlisted people will be allowed to visit/collect the child. This cannot be later than 5pm.
- If a parent/guardian wants to pick up his/her child for the weekend, please book before Thursday so that it won't disturb the smooth running of the weekend program.
- All pocket money has to be surrendered to the bursar's office. **The school is not responsible for any lost money kept in the hostel.**
- UNLABELLED CLOTHING ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE
- Cell phones and radios are not allowed.
- Laptops are a requirement for all students Forms 1 – 6.
- It is advisable for parents/guardians to communicate all boarding related matters/concerns through the Headmaster.
- Parents/guardians are earnestly requested not to seek permission for boarders to leave school before the official break-up time, as this becomes disruptive to the academic program.
- Parents are also requested to observe the dates and times given for fixture free and half term break as staff, catering and support are not available to run the boarding place during these periods.
